1. Context & Problem Horizon

Complex organizations increasingly face **organizational friction** — overlapping mandates, slow decision cycles, and vulnerabilities in risk control. Classic consulting often delivers theoretical reports without a clear execution architecture, leaving leadership to manage the political and operational risk of reform on their own.

2. What GARI Is & Its Core Differentiator

GARI is not a classic consulting firm — it is an independent institutional engineering initiative.

- **Mathematical Approach** — replaces generic “best practices” with mathematical simulation models (a digital twin), testing the impact of budgetary or operational restructuring in a secure virtual environment before real-world implementation.

3. The Execution Model — Four Layers
